Arrival of the aircraft of His Excellency
The President of the United States of America,
John P. K E N N E D Y

While the President stands on the upper
platform of the gangway a salute is fired and
" Hail to the Chief " played.

Area A

At the foot of the gangway the President
is greeted by the French and British Sector
Commandants,

General Toulouse and
General Peel Yates

and on the German side by

The Federal Chancellor,
The Governing Mayor and
The President of the Berlin House of
Representatives

and thereafter by

Federal Minister Dr. Schröder,
Ambassador Knappstein

The President will be accompanied by

Secretary of State Dean Rusk,
General Polk,
Ambassador McGhee,
General Clay,
Mr. Meany.

After the greetings the President and his
party mount a rostrum.

The President is invited to inspect the
Guard of Honor.

At the same time the other ladies and
gentlemen of the President's party, who will
have left the aircraft by another door or
come by another plane, are conducted to Area B.

Area B

President Kennedy, accompanied by
General Toulouse, then inspects the Guard of
Honor made up of detachments of the French,
American and British Forces and the Berlin
Police.

Area C

After inspecting the Guard of Honor
President Kennedy returns to the rostrum,
Area C.

There, before Press, Radio and TV the
Governing Mayor gives a short address of
welcome and President Kennedy makes a
brief statement.

11.10 hours

Stop at the Congress Hall

The vehicles up to and including car 4 drive to Portal 2 of the Congress Hall while the motor-cycle escort and the prominent persons' bus halt on the left-hand side of John-Poster-Dulles Allee at the Congress Hall.

All other vehicles proceed at once to the Brandenburg Gate and there await the arrival of the President's convoy.

In front of the Congress Hall the President is greeted by Herr Leber, Mr. Meany, Herr Sickert, Herr Rosenberg and Mr. Nagy.

President Kennedy and his immediate companions (the occupants of cars 1-4) enter the Congress Hall. The President, the Federal Chancellor, the Governing Mayor, Mr. Stout,

Mr. Behn, Mr. Meany, Herr Leber, Herr Sickert, Herr Rosenberg and Mr. Nagy use the lift. All others use the staircase adjoining the lift.

President Kennedy is greeted by Herr Leber, Chairman of the IG Bau, Steine, Erden (Builders' Trade Union) and Mr. George Meany, the American trade union leader. President Kennedy speaks a few words.

- 11.30 hours Leave the Congress Hall for the Brandenburg Gate
- 11.35 hours Arrive at the Brandenburg Gate
President Kennedy and his immediate companions mount a specially prepared platform
- 11.50 hours Proceed to Checkpoint Charlie
- 12.05 hours Arrive at Checkpoint Charlie
President Kennedy and the occupants of cars up to and including car 5 leave their vehicles
- 12.20 hours Proceed to Schoeneberg Rathaus
- 12.50 hours Arrive at Schoeneberg Rathaus
Vehicles 1-5 drive up to Portal 3 of the Rathaus (Rathausstrasse)
The occupants of buses 6-14 enter the Rathaus via Portal 4 (Rathausstrasse)
President Kennedy and the other occupants of his car proceed to the Governing Mayor's room
All others who travelled in the convoy, including the occupants of car 4, make their way towards the rostrum and await the arrival of the President in the entrance hall of the Rathaus. None of those waiting may mount the rostrum before the President, the Federal Chancellor and the Governing Mayor.
Immediately after their arrival at Rathaus Schoeneberg the occupants of vehicle 5 (prominent persons' bus) and those of cars 12-14 proceed directly to the balcony room (room 1110).
- 13.00 hours Public rally
Addresses will be given in the following order:
President Bach
Chancellor Adenauer
President Kennedy
Governing Mayor Brandt

To conclude his speech the Governing Mayor asks President Kennedy to sign his name in the Golden Book of the City of Berlin.

13.30 hours

After the rally President Kennedy, the Governing Mayor, the Federal Chancellor and the President of the Berlin House of Representatives proceed to room 1114.

All others leave the rostrum for the Brandenburg Hall

In room 1114 the following will be introduced to the President :

Members of the Senate
by the Governing Mayor,

Members of the Berlin House of
Representatives
by President Bach,

Members of the German Bundestag
by the Federal Chancellor.

The Governing Mayor will take this opportunity to hand over the gift of the City of Berlin to the President.

13.45 hours

Meanwhile those guests invited to the banquet in the Brandenburg Hall have taken their places behind their chairs at the table and will remain standing while awaiting the entry of the President.

Except for

The Governing Mayor
President Bach

those taking part in the presentations leave room 1114 and proceed to the Brandenburg Hall.

At the same time those who travelled in the convoy but are not invited to the banquet proceed to room 1102 where a running buffet will be served.

The banquet lasts for 65 minutes.

Directly after the meal the occupants of all vehicles in the President's convoy return via Portals 3 or 4 to the waiting transport while President Kennedy, the Federal Chancellor and the Governing Mayor make a brief reappearance on the rostrum to take their leave of the waiting Berliners.

All others taking part in the banquet remain in the Brandenburg Hall until the convoy has left.

President Kennedy will be made an honorary
member of the Free University, Berlin
The President addresses the students
- 16.00 hours President Kennedy and the American members
of his party proceed to the US Headquarters
in Clay Allee
(Order of vehicles 1)
Inspect detachments of troops of the
US Garrison Berlin
After the President has left the Free
University the Federal Chancellor and his
party proceed directly to Tegel airport
(Order of vehicles 2)
while the Governing Mayor meets the President
at Roseneck at 16.30 hours and accompanies
him to Tegel
- 17.15 hours Departure of President Kennedy for Eire.
Farewell messages by President Kennedy and
Chancellor Adenauer
Also present during the leave-taking will
be the Irish Ambassador to the Federal
Republic of Germany

Dort werden der Regierende Bürgermeister vor Presse, Rundfunk und Fernsehen einige Begrüßungsworte sprechen und Präsident Kennedy eine kurze Erklärung abgeben.
